MEN'S GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME: The best rivalry in the NAIA is renewed tonight in a regular-season finale between Azusa Pacific and Biola. Five months ago this was a dream match-up that many hoped were determine the GSAC champion as this game as so many other times in past years. However, both teams are just jockeying for seeding for the GSAC Postseason Tournament which begins in 3 days.

ABOUT THE COUGARS: Five seniors play their final regular-season game in the Felix Event Center. Four-year Cougar Brice Prather leads the parade in which he is followed by Demario Butler, Chris Thornton, Tristan King, and Scott Zea. Azusa Pacific is 15-1 at home this season.

ABOUT THE EAGLES: Biola is suffering through an uncharacteristic season in which the Eagles are flirting with a sub-.500 record. One of the winningest programs in the GSAC over the past 10 years, the Eagles have been hampered this season by injuries and roster changes. The most notable injury was to freshman center Rocky Hampton, who earlier this season tore up Azusa Pacific for 17 points in the Cougars' dramatic come-from-behind 71-70 victory in La Mirada. Hampton, however, went down the next week with a knee injury and just returned to play last week.



WOMEN'S GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME: The NAIA's No. 12-ranked Azusa Pacific is locked into the No. 3 seed in the first round of the GSAC Postseason Tournament, but the Cougars can use tonight's regular-season finale against Biola as an opportunity to get back on track after a 91-79 loss to California Baptist last Friday. The loss was just the third since November for Azusa Pacific.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: Vanguard has clinched the regular season title, and with it, the GSAC's first automatic bid to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball Championship in Jackson, Tenn., March 14-20. Point Loma Nazarene has earned the No. 2 seed for the upcoming GSAC Postseason Tournament while Azusa Pacific and Westmont go 3 and 4, respectively. The top 4 seeds all host first round games Wednesday.

ABOUT THE EAGLES: Biola enters tonight's contest with the chance of tying for the eighth spot in the conference standings with a victory, but the Eagles would lose any tiebreaking scenarios for the eighth and final spot in the conference's postseason tournament. Biola has just 2 seniors, and after a 117-44 defeat at Vanguard Saturday, the Eagles would like to avoid ending their 2006-07 campaign on a 5-game losing streak.
