MEN'S GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME: Azusa Pacific looks to bounce back from a difficult double-overtime loss at Concordia with tonight's hosting of Hope International. The Cougars have won 12 of 13 at home this year and 14 of 15 dating to last year.

ABOUT THE COUGARS: The GSAC's top offensive team, Azusa Pacific is averaging a hefty 90 points a game this season and features 5 players who have scored at least 20 points in a game this season. The trio of Demario Butler, Scott Zea and Mike Danielian combined for 78 points in the Cougars' game at Concordia Saturday evening with Butler and Danielian each tallying a career-high 27. Currently 19-4 on the season, the Cougars are just 1 win away from their GSAC-record 15th straight 20-win season. Azusa Pacific hits the long GSAC road for the next 2 games, first going to San Diego and then Fresno.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: It's already been a banner season for Hope International, which is under the direction of former Cougar assistant Greg Pappas. Earlier this year, the Royals snapped a 40-game losing streak by beating Rocky Mountain College here in the Felix Event Center during the Cougar Classic. Then in December, HIU collected its first GSAC victory in 3 seasons with a stunning 60-58 upset of the NAIA's then No. 11-ranked Point Loma Nazarene. The Royals collected another GSAC win over Vanguard 2 weeks ago. HIU is in a difficult stretch of the conference schedule where it plays the GSAC's top 4 teams in the next 5 contests.



WOMEN'S GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME: Azusa Pacific has the pedal to the mettle and as a result is playing its best basketball over the past 20 years of the program. The Cougars have won a program-record 15 straight at home and gladly welcome Hope International to the Felix Event Center for tonight's GSAC contest.

ABOUT THE COUGARS: Outside of Costa Mesa where the top-ranked team resides, there may be no hotter team in the nation than Azusa Pacific, winner in 16 of the past 17 games including the past 6 in a row. Only an 8-point loss at No. 1-ranked Vanguard has blemished the Cougar slate over the past 2 months. The leader of the Cougar streak is GSAC Player of the Year candidate Monica Somers, who is averaging 22.5 points and 3.0 assists in the past 17 games. She needs just 3 points tonight to become only the fourth Cougar ever to score 1,600 points in a career. Somers isn't acting alone, but rather is receiving steady support from forward Abby Johnson and center Meliame Halaufia, who together are averaging 26 points and 13 rebounds since the start of December.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: Hope International is trying to collect its first-ever back-to-back postseason berths in program history, but the Royals are going to need a rally. They've dropped 7 of their past 8 games, including the past 5 in a row, to fall 2 games off the pace for a playoff spot. Reigning GSAC Coach of the Year T.J. Hardeman is leaning on Jasmine Nault to lead the way. Nault is averaging 24.1 points over the past 9 games.
