**Women's Basketball Notes**

**ABOUT THE COUGARS:** With Saturday's win over Point Loma Nazarene, Azusa Pacific won its ninth in a row to move into a tie with California Baptist for the GSAC lead. The Cougars' last defeat was the first meeting with Cal Baptist, when Dana Olsen scored the game-winner with 5 seconds left in regulation for the 61-60 win. The teams enter tonight's game tied, and the winner gains the inside track to the conference regular-season crown. Azusa Pacific leads the GSAC in scoring, averaging just under 80 points a game. Junior Eboni Sadler averages a team-high 15.6 points in GSAC play while junior guard Briana Hall averages a GSAC-best 6.7 assists per game.

**ABOUT THE LANCERS:** Cal Baptist suffered its first GSAC loss since November last Thursday in an 83-71 loss at Westmont, ending a run of 12 straight conference victories. Dana Olsen averages a team-high 20.2 points for the Lancers, who feature 5

**ABOUT THE COUGARS:** Azusa Pacific has a firm grip on second place in the GSAC, with its only 2 conference defeats coming against first-place Concordia. Center Reggie Owens was selected GSAC Player of the Week with a pair of solid performances last week. Owens posted a 12-point, 13-rebound effort, his eighth double-double of the year, to lead the Cougars to a road win at Biola, and he had 13 points and 9 rebounds against Point Loma. The Cougars are hitting just over 50 percent from the field on the year, with Owens' 16.5 ppg and 65% FG percentage leading the way, while senior Danny Nugent is the NAIA leader in 3-point shooting percentage (.544).

**ABOUT THE LANCERS:** Cal Baptist's seventh-place GSAC standing is deceptive, as the Lancers' 6-8 conference record includes 6 single-digit losses. California Baptist hasn't won or lost more than 3 in a row all year, and the Lancers are coming off a 77-72 loss at Westmont last week.
