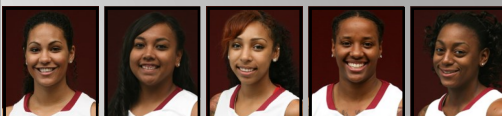

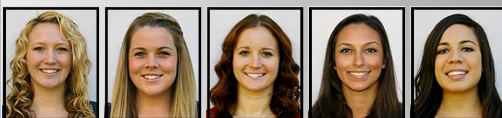

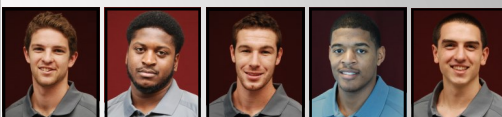

**ABOUT THE COUGARS:** Azusa Pacific hit its stride last week, breaking a weeks-long tie at the top of the GSAC standings with California Baptist by posting an 82-70 win over the Lancers at home. The Cougars then extended their lead to 2 games with a 6-point road win over nationally-ranked Westmont to take control of the GSAC regular-season title race. During its current 11-game winning streak, Azusa Pacific is out-rebounding foes by over 12 per game, including the first meeting with Vanguard when the Cougars posted a 47-23 edge on the boards.

**ABOUT THE LIONS:** Vanguard has won or shared the GSAC regular-season crown 7 of the past 8 years, but the Lions are tied for fourth in the conference with 4 games to play and are fighting for a GSAC Tournament first-round home game. Just over a week ago, the Lions dropped back-to-back home games to Biola and Westmont before bouncing back for a crucial 79-78 road win

**ABOUT THE COUGARS:** Azusa Pacific enters into an intriguing part of its schedule in which the final 4 games are against the 4 bottom teams of the GSAC. Yet this is no the time to rest or relax. With a solid lock on a second place finish in the GSAC and a distantly remote chance of winning the conference crown, the Cougars need to fine-tune their game as they prepare for the NAIA Tournament in mid-March. Azusa Pacific has won 4 straight, all by 12 points or more, including a 29-point shellacking of Westmont last Saturday, Azusa Pacific's largest margin of victory ever in 85 meetings with the Warriors.

**ABOUT THE LIONS:** First-year Vanguard coach and former Concordia standout guard Rhett Soliday is battling to get his Lions back into the GSAC Postseason Tourney after last year's absence. The Lions have dropped 6 straight, but 2 were in OT, including a triple-overtime setback to Westmont last week.
