Four meet records were set at the opening day of competition at the 1993 NAIA National Outdoor Track and Field Championships, including the fastest men's 10,000 meters run in the world this year.

Julius Randich of Lubbock Christian won the men's 10,000 in 28:16.95. Randich, from Kenya, lowered the meet record he set last year by 47 seconds.

Two of the records were set in the women's heptathlon by Kim Vanderhoek of host Simon Fraser. Vanderhoek ran the 200 meters in 24.79 and had a shot put of 41-11 1/2 to roll up 3,382 points through four events. Vanderhoek holds the meet record for the heptathlon at 5,626 points.

The other record was set by Deon Hemmings in a women's 400 meter hurdles heat. Hemmings ran a 56.07, shaving nearly a half-second off her old record set last year.

Only seven finals were held on the opening day of the three-day competition. Western Oregon State had two men's winners Thursday, with Jean Zirignon winning the long jump and Ryan Parshail claiming the hammer throw. Nary Kennedy of Point Loma Nazarene won the men's javelin.

In women's finals, Kim Hayes of Doane won the shot put, Central State won the 800 medley relay and Tigest Moreda of Wayland Baptist, who was an Olympic finalist for Ethiopia last year, won the 10,000.

Rodney Wallace of Wayland Baptist leads the men's decathlon with 3,728, just 37 points ahead of D.J. Seydel of Pacific Lutheran.

The women's long jump finals were postponed until Saturday because of a heavy rain storm.
