AZUSA PACIFIC-CAL STATE HAYWARD GAME NOTES

Azusa Pacific and Cal State Hayward combined for 81 points, including 41 in the fourth quarter, and 1,073 yards in total offense as Cal State Hayward collected its first victory of the season with a 45-36 win at Azusa, Saturday.

Azusa Pacific's defense entered the game ranked fourth in the NAIA in total defense (212.7 a game), but gave up 666 yards to the Pioneers in total offense -- the most ever allowed by an Azusa Pacific defense.

The Pioneers were led by senior QB Ray Marrow, who completed 24-of-35 passes for 367 yards and 3 TDs. Junior WR Shane Aldrete caught a Cal State Hayward-record 11 passes for a whopping 244 yards and was on the receiving end of all 3 of Marrow's TD strikes.

Junior Martel Black paced the Pioneers with 156 yards rushing on 19 carries and scored 2 TDs (4 and 27 yards).

Azusa Pacific QB Jack Manu (Long Beach, Calif./Paramount HS) had career-best day, completing 9-of-20 passes for 273 yards and 3 TDs, including a school-record 82-yarder to senior WR Dan Mitchell (broke the former APU record of 77 yards from Dave Williams to John Catlett set in 1983). Mitchell, who ran his receiving streak to 31 consecutive games, caught 3 passes for 127 yards and was on the receiving end of 2 Manu TD strikes.

The 2 schools scored 4 TDs in the first 5:02 of the fourth quarter and went on to pile up 41 points in the quarter. Cal State Hayward jumped out to a 12-0 lead in the first quarter and held a 12-7 lead at halftime. The Pioneers pushed the lead 26-7 and never let Azusa Pacific closer than a 39-30 count with 9:58 left in the game.
