GAME NOTES

Azusa Pacific never trailed La Verne and with the 37-32 victory over the Leos, the Cougars snapped a 2-game losing streak. The Cougars took the opening kickoff and drove 80 yards in 7 plays to register a TD on James Dixon's 2-yard run. The Cougar defense then stopped La Verne on the ensuing drive, but on the first play of their second possession, Cougar FB Navid Abassi fumbled the ball on the Azusa Pacific 25 and La Verne's Jake McDonald landed on the loose ball. Leo QB Ryan Campuzano then hit Bill Battin on the first play from scrimmage for a 25-yard TD strike.

The Cougars led 20-13 at the half, but La Verne drove 67 yards on 7 plays on the opening drive of the second half to knot the score at 20 when Danny Pasquil scored from 7 yards out. Azusa Pacific responded on the next drive and went 65 yards on a time-hogging 13-play drive (6 minutes, 40 seconds) capped by Jack Manu's 10-yard TD run.

Azusa Pacific expanded its lead to 34-26 on Dixon's second TD of the day, a 4-yard run with 11 seconds left in the third quarter. Azusa Pacific then put the game on ice with its opening drive of the fourth quarter. The Cougars held onto the ball for 9 minutes, 3 seconds that drive and though the it ended on a Randy Horton interception in the endzone, the time taken off the clock killed the Leo's chances of a comeback.

For the game, Azusa Pacific converted 10-of-16 third downs, including the first 8 of the second half and 4 during its crucial 9:03 fourth quarter drive.

In the second half, the Cougars held onto the ball for 19:33 and ran 41 plays to La Verne's 23.

Azusa Pacific scored its most points since tallying 42 against San Diego in 1991.

The Cougars' 318 yards rushing are the most by the Cougars since they ran for 320 yards vs. Redlands in a 34-27 Cougar victory in 1989.

Azusa Pacific now leads the series with La Verne 16-13. Current Azusa Pacific coach and 1957 La Verne alum Jim Milhon defeated the Leos in their own homecoming. Milhon is now 12-4 vs. his alma mater.
